### Knowing God's will

#### **John 7:1 (NKJV)**

1 After these things Jesus walked in Galilee; for He did not want to walk in Judea, because the Jews sought to kill Him.

#### **John 7:2 (NKJV)**

2 Now the Jews' Feast of Tabernacles was at hand.

#### **John 7:3 (NKJV)**

3 His brothers therefore said to Him, "Depart from here and go into Judea, that Your disciples also may see the works that You are doing.

#### **John 7:4 (NKJV)**

4 For no one does anything in secret while he himself seeks to be known openly. If You do these things, show Yourself to the world."

#### **John 7:5 (NKJV)**

5 For even His brothers did not believe in Him.

#### **John 7:6 (NKJV)**

6 Then Jesus said to them, "My time has not yet come, but your time is always ready.

#### **John 7:7 (NKJV)**

7 The world cannot hate you, but it hates Me because I testify of it that its works are evil.

#### **John 7:8 (NKJV)**

8 You go up to this feast. I am not yet going up to this feast, for My time has not yet fully come."

#### **John 7:9 (NKJV)**

9 When He had said these things to them, He remained in Galilee.

#### **John 7:10 (NKJV)**

10 But when His brothers had gone up, then He also went up to the feast, not openly, but as it were in secret.

#### **John 7:11 (NKJV)**

11 Then the Jews sought Him at the feast, and said, "Where is He?"

#### **John 7:12 (NKJV)**

12 And there was much complaining among the people concerning Him. Some said, "He is good"; others said, "No, on the contrary, He deceives the people."

#### **John 7:13 (NKJV)**

13 However, no one spoke openly of Him for fear of the Jews.

#### **John 7:14 (NKJV)**

14 Now about the middle of the feast Jesus went up into the temple and taught.

#### **John 7:15 (NKJV)**

15 And the Jews marveled, saying, "How does this Man know letters, having never studied?"

#### **John 7:16 (NKJV)**

16 Jesus answered them and said, "My doctrine is not Mine, but His who sent Me.

#### **John 7:17 (NKJV)**

17 If anyone wills to do His will, he shall know concerning the doctrine, whether it is from God or whether I speak on My own authority.

#### **John 7:18 (NKJV)**

18 He who speaks from himself seeks his own glory; but He who seeks the glory of the One who sent Him is true, and no unrighteousness is in Him.

#### **John 5:30 (NKJV)**

30 I can of Myself do nothing. As I hear, I judge; and My judgment is righteous, because I do not seek My own will but the will of the

Father who sent Me.

### **Acts 22:14 (NKJV)**

14 Then he said, 'The God of our fathers has chosen you that you should know His will, and see the Just One, and hear the voice of His mouth.

### **Psalms 143:10 (NKJV)**

10 Teach me to do Your will, For You are my God; Your Spirit is good. Lead me in the land of uprightness.

It is God's will that you should be saved

### **2 Peter 3:9 (NKJV)**

9 The Lord is not slack concerning His promise, as some count slackness, but is longsuffering toward us, not willing that any should perish but that all should come to repentance.

### **1 Timothy 2:4 (NKJV)**

4 who desires all men to be saved and to come to the knowledge of the truth.

### **John 3:36 (NKJV)**

36 He who believes in the Son has everlasting life; and he who does not believe the Son shall not see life, but the wrath of God abides on him."

### **Romans 10:9 (NKJV)**

9 that if you confess with your mouth the Lord Jesus and believe in your heart that God has raised Him from the dead, you will be saved.

### **Romans 10:10 (NKJV)**

10 For with the heart one believes unto righteousness, and with the mouth confession is made unto salvation.

### **Romans 10:11 (NKJV)**

11 For the Scripture says, "Whoever believes on Him will not be put to shame."

### **Romans 10:12 (NKJV)**

12 For there is no distinction between Jew and Greek, for the same Lord over all is rich to all who call upon Him.

### **Romans 10:13 (NKJV)**

13 For "whoever calls on the name of the LORD shall be saved."

It is God's will that you give Him your entire life

### **1 Corinthians 6:19 (NKJV)**

19 Or do you not know that your body is the temple of the Holy Spirit who is in you, whom you have from God, and you are not your own?

### **1 Corinthians 6:20 (NKJV)**

20 For you were bought at a price; therefore glorify God in your body and in your spirit, which are God's.

It is God's will that you be continually filled with His Holy Spirit

### **Ephesians 5:17 (NKJV)**

17 Therefore do not be unwise, but understand what the will of the Lord is.

### **Ephesians 5:18 (NKJV)**

18 And do not be drunk with wine, in which is dissipation; but be filled with the Spirit,

### 1 John 1:7 (NKJV)

7 But if we walk in the light as He is in the light, we have fellowship with one another, and the blood of Jesus Christ His Son cleanses us from all sin.

### 1 John 1:8 (NKJV)

8 If we say that we have no sin, we deceive ourselves, and the truth is not in us.

### 1 John 1:9 (NKJV)

9 If we confess our sins, He is faithful and just to forgive us our sins and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness.

### John 7:37 (NKJV)

37 On the last day, that great day of the feast, Jesus stood and cried out, saying, "If anyone thirsts, let him come to Me and drink.

### John 7:38 (NKJV)

38 He who believes in Me, as the Scripture has said, out of his heart will flow rivers of living water."

### John 7:39 (NKJV)

39 But this He spoke concerning the Spirit, whom those believing in Him would receive; for the Holy Spirit was not yet given, because Jesus was not yet glorified.

### Luke 11:13 (NKJV)

13 If you then, being evil, know how to give good gifts to your children, how much more will your heavenly Father give the Holy Spirit to those who ask Him!"

It is God's will that you be submissive to all God's ordained authority

### 1 Peter 2:13 (NKJV)

13 Therefore submit yourselves to every ordinance of man for the Lord's sake, whether to the king as supreme,

### 1 Peter 2:14 (NKJV)

14 or to governors, as to those who are sent by him for the punishment of evildoers and for the praise of those who do good.

### 1 Peter 2:15 (NKJV)

15 For this is the will of God, that by doing good you may put to silence the ignorance of foolish men--

Submit yourselves therefore to God

### James 4:7 (NKJV)

7 Therefore submit to God. Resist the devil and he will flee from you.

### Acts 4:18 (NKJV)

18 So they called them and commanded them not to speak at all nor teach in the name of Jesus.

### Acts 4:19 (NKJV)

19 But Peter and John answered and said to them, "Whether it is right in the sight of God to listen to you more than to God, you judge.

### Acts 4:20 (NKJV)

20 For we cannot but speak the things which we have seen and heard."

We must submit ourselves "one to another in the Fear of God."

### Ephesians 5:21 (NKJV)

21 submitting to one another in the fear of God.

We must submit ourselves to our local church leaders.

### Hebrews 13:17 (NKJV)

17 Obey those who rule over you, and be submissive, for they watch out for your souls, as those who must give account. Let them do

so with joy and not with grief, for that would be unprofitable for you.

### **Psalm 105:14 (NKJV)**

14 He permitted no one to do them wrong; Yes, He rebuked kings for their sakes,

### **Psalm 105:15 (NKJV)**

15 Saying, "Do not touch My anointed ones, And do My prophets no harm."

We must submit to civil government authorities.

### **Romans 13:1 (NKJV)**

1 Let every soul be subject to the governing authorities. For there is no authority except from God, and the authorities that exist are appointed by God.

### **Romans 13:2 (NKJV)**

2 Therefore whoever resists the authority resists the ordinance of God, and those who resist will bring judgment on themselves.

We must submit to authorities found in the workplace.

### **Ephesians 6:5 (NKJV)**

5 Bondservants, be obedient to those who are your masters according to the flesh, with fear and trembling, in sincerity of heart, as to Christ;

### **Ephesians 6:6 (NKJV)**

6 not with eyeservice, as men-pleasers, but as bondservants of Christ, doing the will of God from the heart,

### **Ephesians 6:7 (NKJV)**

7 with goodwill doing service, as to the Lord, and not to men,

Wives submit to their husbands.

### **Ephesians 5:22 (NKJV)**

22 Wives, submit to your own husbands, as to the Lord.

Children submit to their parents.

### **Ephesians 6:1 (NKJV)**

1 Children, obey your parents in the Lord, for this is right.

### **Ephesians 6:2 (NKJV)**

2 "Honor your father and mother," which is the first commandment with promise:

### **Ephesians 6:3 (NKJV)**

3 "that it may be well with you and you may live long on the earth."

Youth submit to their elders.

### **1 Peter 5:5 (NKJV)**

5 Likewise you younger people, submit yourselves to your elders. Yes, all of you be submissive to one another, and be clothed with humility, for "God resists the proud, But gives grace to the humble."
