Proverbs 31:10-31

#### **Proverbs 31:10-11 (NKJV)**

10 Who can find a virtuous wife? For her worth is far above rubies. 11 The heart of her husband safely trusts her; So he will have no lack of gain.

#### **Proverbs 31:12-13 (NKJV)**

12 She does him good and not evil All the days of her life. 13 She seeks wool and flax, And willingly works with her hands.

#### **Proverbs 31:14-15 (NKJV)**

14 She is like the merchant ships, She brings her food from afar. 15 She also rises while it is yet night, And provides food for her household, And a portion for her maidservants.

#### **Proverbs 31:16-17 (NKJV)**

16 She considers a field and buys it; From her profits she plants a vineyard. 17 She girds herself with strength, And strengthens her arms.

#### **Proverbs 31:18-19 (NKJV)**

18 She perceives that her merchandise is good, And her lamp does not go out by night. 19 She stretches out her hands to the distaff, And her hand holds the spindle.

#### **Proverbs 31:20-21 (NKJV)**

20 She extends her hand to the poor, Yes, she reaches out her hands to the needy. 21 She is not afraid of snow for her household, For all her household is clothed with scarlet.

#### **Proverbs 31:22-23 (NKJV)**

22 She makes tapestry for herself; Her clothing is fine linen and purple. 23 Her husband is known in the gates, When he sits among the elders of the land.

#### **Proverbs 31:24-25 (NKJV)**

24 She makes linen garments and sells them, And supplies sashes for the merchants. 25 Strength and honor are her clothing; She shall rejoice in time to come.

#### **Proverbs 31:26-27 (NKJV)**

26 She opens her mouth with wisdom, And on her tongue is the law of kindness. 27 She watches over the ways of her household, And does not eat the bread of idleness.

#### **Proverbs 31:28-29 (NKJV)**

28 Her children rise up and call her blessed; Her husband also, and he praises her: 29 "Many daughters have done well, But you excel them all."

#### **Proverbs 31:30-31 (NKJV)**

30 Charm is deceitful and beauty is passing, But a woman who fears the LORD, she shall be praised. 31 Give her of the fruit of her hands, And let her own works praise her in the gates.

### **Romans 12:2 (NKJV)**

2 And do not be conformed to this world, but be transformed by the renewing of your mind, that you may prove what is that good and acceptable and perfect will of God.

### **2 Timothy 3:1-2 (NKJV)**

1 But know this, that in the last days perilous times will come: 2 For men will be lovers of themselves, lovers of money, boasters, proud, blasphemers, disobedient to parents, unthankful, unholy,

### **2 Timothy 3:3-4 (NKJV)**

3 unloving, unforgiving, slanderers, without self-control, brutal, despisers of good, 4 traitors, headstrong, haughty, lovers of pleasure rather than lovers of God,

### **2 Timothy 3:5 (NKJV)**

5 having a form of godliness but denying its power. And from such people turn away!

### **Ephesians 5:23-24 (NKJV)**

23 For the husband is head of the wife, as also Christ is head of the church; and He is the Savior of the body. 24 Therefore, just as the church is subject to Christ, so let the wives be to their own husbands in everything.

### **Ephesians 5:25-26 (NKJV)**

25 Husbands, love your wives, just as Christ also loved the church and gave Himself for her, 26 that He might sanctify and cleanse her with the washing of water by the word,

### **Ephesians 5:27-28 (NKJV)**

27 that He might present her to Himself a glorious church, not having spot or wrinkle or any such thing, but that she should be holy and without blemish. 28 So husbands ought to love their own wives as their own bodies; he who loves his wife loves himself.

### **Ephesians 5:29 (NKJV)**

29 For no one ever hated his own flesh, but nourishes and cherishes it, just as the Lord does the church.
