### God's New Covenant

#### Isaiah 55:1 (NKJV)

1 "Ho! Everyone who thirsts, Come to the waters; And you who have no money, Come, buy and eat. Yes, come, buy wine and milk Without money and without price.

#### Isaiah 55:2 (NKJV)

2 Why do you spend money for what is not bread, And your wages for what does not satisfy? Listen carefully to Me, and eat what is good, And let your soul delight itself in abundance.

#### Isaiah 55:3 (NKJV)

3 Incline your ear, and come to Me. Hear, and your soul shall live; And I will make an everlasting covenant with you-- The sure mercies of David.

#### Isaiah 55:6 (NKJV)

6 Seek the LORD while He may be found, Call upon Him while He is near.

#### Isaiah 55:7 (NKJV)

7 Let the wicked forsake his way, And the unrighteous man his thoughts; Let him return to the LORD, And He will have mercy on him; And to our God, For He will abundantly pardon.

#### Isaiah 55:8 (NKJV)

8 "For My thoughts are not your thoughts, Nor are your ways My ways," says the LORD.

#### Isaiah 55:9 (NKJV)

9 "For as the heavens are higher than the earth, So are My ways higher than your ways, And My thoughts than your thoughts.

### Jesus with Peter in the boat

Luke 5:1-11

#### Luke 5:1 (NKJV)

1 So it was, as the multitude pressed about Him to hear the word of God, that He stood by the Lake of Gennesaret,

#### Luke 5:2 (NKJV)

2 and saw two boats standing by the lake; but the fishermen had gone from them and were washing their nets.

#### Luke 5:3 (NKJV)

3 Then He got into one of the boats, which was Simon's, and asked him to put out a little from the land. And He sat down and taught the multitudes from the boat.

#### Luke 5:4 (NKJV)

4 When He had stopped speaking, He said to Simon, "Launch out into the deep and let down your nets for a catch."

#### Luke 5:5 (NKJV)

5 But Simon answered and said to Him, "Master, we have toiled all night and caught nothing; nevertheless at Your word I will let down the net."

#### Luke 5:6 (NKJV)

6 And when they had done this, they caught a great number of fish, and their net was breaking.

#### Luke 5:7 (NKJV)

7 So they signaled to their partners in the other boat to come and help them. And they came and filled both the boats, so that they began to sink.

#### Luke 5:8 (NKJV)

8 When Simon Peter saw it, he fell down at Jesus' knees, saying, "Depart from me, for I am a sinful man, O Lord!"

#### Luke 5:9 (NKJV)

9 For he and all who were with him were astonished at the catch of fish which they had taken;

#### Luke 5:10 (NKJV)

10 and so also were James and John, the sons of Zebedee, who were partners with Simon. And Jesus said to Simon, "Do not be afraid.

From now on you will catch men."

### **Luke 5:11 (NKJV)**

11 So when they had brought their boats to land, they forsook all and followed Him.

### **Hebrews 4:15 (NKJV)**

15 For we do not have a High Priest who cannot sympathize with our weaknesses, but was in all points tempted as we are, yet without sin.

### **Hebrews 4:16 (NKJV)**

16 Let us therefore come boldly to the throne of grace, that we may obtain mercy and find grace to help in time of need.

### **Jesus with Jairus**

Mark 5:21-24 and Mark 5:35-42

### **Mark 5:21 (NKJV)**

21 Now when Jesus had crossed over again by boat to the other side, a great multitude gathered to Him; and He was by the sea.

### **Mark 5:22 (NKJV)**

22 And behold, one of the rulers of the synagogue came, Jairus by name. And when he saw Him, he fell at His feet

### **Mark 5:23 (NKJV)**

23 and begged Him earnestly, saying, "My little daughter lies at the point of death. Come and lay Your hands on her, that she may be healed, and she will live."

### **Mark 5:24 (NKJV)**

24 So Jesus went with him, and a great multitude followed Him and thronged Him.

### **Mark 5:35 (NKJV)**

35 While He was still speaking, some came from the ruler of the synagogue's house who said, "Your daughter is dead. Why trouble the Teacher any further?"

### **Mark 5:36 (NKJV)**

36 As soon as Jesus heard the word that was spoken, He said to the ruler of the synagogue, "Do not be afraid; only believe."

### **Mark 5:37 (NKJV)**

37 And He permitted no one to follow Him except Peter, James, and John the brother of James.

### **Mark 5:38 (NKJV)**

38 Then He came to the house of the ruler of the synagogue, and saw a tumult and those who wept and wailed loudly.

### **Mark 5:39 (NKJV)**

39 When He came in, He said to them, "Why make this commotion and weep? The child is not dead, but sleeping."

### **Mark 5:40 (NKJV)**

40 And they ridiculed Him. But when He had put them all outside, He took the father and the mother of the child, and those who were with Him, and entered where the child was lying.

### **Mark 5:41 (NKJV)**

41 Then He took the child by the hand, and said to her, "Talitha, cumi," which is translated, "Little girl, I say to you, arise."

### **Mark 5:42 (NKJV)**

42 Immediately the girl arose and walked, for she was twelve years of age. And they were overcome with great amazement.

### **Proverbs 18:24 (NKJV)**

24 A man who has friends must himself be friendly, But there is a friend who sticks closer than a brother.

### **Jesus and Zacchaeus the tax collector**

Luke 19:1-10

### **Luke 19:1 (NKJV)**

1 Then Jesus entered and passed through Jericho.

### **Luke 19:2 (NKJV)**

2 Now behold, there was a man named Zacchaeus who was a chief tax collector, and he was rich.

### **Luke 19:3 (NKJV)**

3 And he sought to see who Jesus was, but could not because of the crowd, for he was of short stature.

### **Luke 19:4 (NKJV)**

4 So he ran ahead and climbed up into a sycamore tree to see Him, for He was going to pass that way.

### **Luke 19:5 (NKJV)**

5 And when Jesus came to the place, He looked up and saw him, and said to him, "Zacchaeus, make haste and come down, for today I must stay at your house."

### **Luke 19:6 (NKJV)**

6 So he made haste and came down, and received Him joyfully.

### **Luke 19:7 (NKJV)**

7 But when they saw it, they all complained, saying, "He has gone to be a guest with a man who is a sinner."

### **Luke 19:8 (NKJV)**

8 Then Zacchaeus stood and said to the Lord, "Look, Lord, I give half of my goods to the poor; and if I have taken anything from anyone by false accusation, I restore fourfold."

### **Luke 19:9 (NKJV)**

9 And Jesus said to him, "Today salvation has come to this house, because he also is a son of Abraham;

### **Luke 19:10 (NKJV)**

10 for the Son of Man has come to seek and to save that which was lost."

### **Mark 2:15 (NKJV)**

15 Now it happened, as He was dining in Levi's house, that many tax collectors and sinners also sat together with Jesus and His disciples; for there were many, and they followed Him.

### **Mark 2:16 (NKJV)**

16 And when the scribes and Pharisees saw Him eating with the tax collectors and sinners, they said to His disciples, "How is it that He eats and drinks with tax collectors and sinners?"

### **Mark 2:17 (NKJV)**

17 When Jesus heard it, He said to them, "Those who are well have no need of a physician, but those who are sick. I did not come to call the righteous, but sinners, to repentance."

### **Jesus and the Samaritan woman at the well**

John 4:5-26

### **John 4:5 (NKJV)**

5 So He came to a city of Samaria which is called Sychar, near the plot of ground that Jacob gave to his son Joseph.

### **John 4:6 (NKJV)**

6 Now Jacob's well was there. Jesus therefore, being wearied from His journey, sat thus by the well. It was about the sixth hour.

### **John 4:7 (NKJV)**

7 A woman of Samaria came to draw water. Jesus said to her, "Give Me a drink."

### **John 4:8 (NKJV)**

8 For His disciples had gone away into the city to buy food.

### **John 4:9 (NKJV)**

9 Then the woman of Samaria said to Him, "How is it that You, being a Jew, ask a drink from me, a Samaritan woman?" For Jews have no dealings with Samaritans.

### **John 4:10 (NKJV)**

10 Jesus answered and said to her, "If you knew the gift of God, and who it is who says to you, 'Give Me a drink,' you would have asked

Him, and He would have given you living water."

### **John 4:11 (NKJV)**

11 The woman said to Him, "Sir, You have nothing to draw with, and the well is deep. Where then do You get that living water?"

### **John 4:12 (NKJV)**

12 Are You greater than our father Jacob, who gave us the well, and drank from it himself, as well as his sons and his livestock?"

### **John 4:13 (NKJV)**

13 Jesus answered and said to her, "Whoever drinks of this water will thirst again,

### **John 4:14 (NKJV)**

14 but whoever drinks of the water that I shall give him will never thirst. But the water that I shall give him will become in him a fountain of water springing up into everlasting life."

### **John 4:15 (NKJV)**

15 The woman said to Him, "Sir, give me this water, that I may not thirst, nor come here to draw."

### **John 4:16 (NKJV)**

16 Jesus said to her, "Go, call your husband, and come here."

### **John 4:17 (NKJV)**

17 The woman answered and said, "I have no husband." Jesus said to her, "You have well said, 'I have no husband,'

### **John 4:18 (NKJV)**

18 for you have had five husbands, and the one whom you now have is not your husband; in that you spoke truly."

### **John 4:19 (NKJV)**

19 The woman said to Him, "Sir, I perceive that You are a prophet.

### **John 4:20 (NKJV)**

20 Our fathers worshiped on this mountain, and you Jews say that in Jerusalem is the place where one ought to worship."

### **John 4:21 (NKJV)**

21 Jesus said to her, "Woman, believe Me, the hour is coming when you will neither on this mountain, nor in Jerusalem, worship the Father.

### **John 4:22 (NKJV)**

22 You worship what you do not know; we know what we worship, for salvation is of the Jews.

### **John 4:23 (NKJV)**

23 But the hour is coming, and now is, when the true worshipers will worship the Father in spirit and truth; for the Father is seeking such to worship Him.

### **John 4:24 (NKJV)**

24 God is Spirit, and those who worship Him must worship in spirit and truth."

### **John 4:25 (NKJV)**

25 The woman said to Him, "I know that Messiah is coming" (who is called Christ). "When He comes, He will tell us all things."

### **John 4:26 (NKJV)**

26 Jesus said to her, "I who speak to you am He."

### **John 7:38 (NKJV)**

38 He who believes in Me, as the Scripture has said, out of his heart will flow rivers of living water."

### **1 Corinthians 1:26 (NKJV)**

26 For you see your calling, brethren, that not many wise according to the flesh, not many mighty, not many noble, are called.

### **1 Corinthians 1:27 (NKJV)**

27 But God has chosen the foolish things of the world to put to shame the wise, and God has chosen the weak things of the world to put to shame the things which are mighty;

### **1 Corinthians 1:28 (NKJV)**

28 and the base things of the world and the things which are despised God has chosen, and the things which are not, to bring to nothing the things that are,

### **1 Corinthians 1:29 (NKJV)**

29 that no flesh should glory in His presence.

### **1 Corinthians 1:30 (NKJV)**

30 But of Him you are in Christ Jesus, who became for us wisdom from God--and righteousness and sanctification and redemption--

### **1 Corinthians 1:31 (NKJV)**

31 that, as it is written, "He who glories, let him glory in the LORD."

### **Jesus and the woman caught in adultery**

John 8:1-11

#### **John 8:1 (NKJV)**

1 But Jesus went to the Mount of Olives.

#### **John 8:2 (NKJV)**

2 Now early in the morning He came again into the temple, and all the people came to Him; and He sat down and taught them.

#### **John 8:3 (NKJV)**

3 Then the scribes and Pharisees brought to Him a woman caught in adultery. And when they had set her in the midst,

#### **John 8:4 (NKJV)**

4 they said to Him, "Teacher, this woman was caught in adultery, in the very act.

#### **John 8:5 (NKJV)**

5 Now Moses, in the law, commanded us that such should be stoned. But what do You say?"

#### **John 8:6 (NKJV)**

6 This they said, testing Him, that they might have something of which to accuse Him. But Jesus stooped down and wrote on the ground with His finger, as though He did not hear.

#### **John 8:7 (NKJV)**

7 So when they continued asking Him, He raised Himself up and said to them, "He who is without sin among you, let him throw a stone at her first."

#### **John 8:8 (NKJV)**

8 And again He stooped down and wrote on the ground.

#### **John 8:9 (NKJV)**

9 Then those who heard it, being convicted by their conscience, went out one by one, beginning with the oldest even to the last. And Jesus was left alone, and the woman standing in the midst.

#### **John 8:10 (NKJV)**

10 When Jesus had raised Himself up and saw no one but the woman, He said to her, "Woman, where are those accusers of yours? Has no one condemned you?"

#### **John 8:11 (NKJV)**

11 She said, "No one, Lord." And Jesus said to her, "Neither do I condemn you; go and sin no more."

### **Romans 8:1 (NKJV)**

1 There is therefore now no condemnation to those who are in Christ Jesus, who do not walk according to the flesh, but according to the Spirit.
